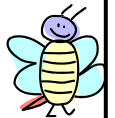


From the Principal!

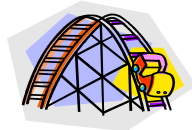
Mark Your Calendars

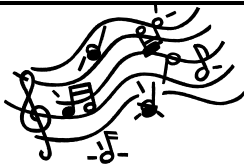
