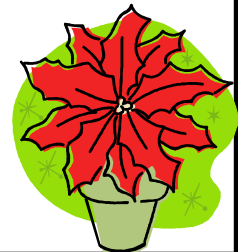
Parents, it's getting cold outside. Please make sure your student is dressed warmly for recess. Thank you!
